At its meeting of March 18, 2022, the Board of the Shandon-San Juan Groundwater Sustainability Agency (SSJ GSA) authorized me to send this Notice of Intent to hold a hearing to consider adoption and submission of edits to the Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) for the Paso Robles Groundwater Sub-basin of the Salinas Valley Basin, No. 3.004.06 (Basin) in response to deficiencies outlined by the Department of Water Resources. The SSJ GSA is working with the other GSAs in the Basin to prepare these edits to the GSP for the Basin. This notice is a continuation of our notice of July 15, 2019, of our Resolution 19-005 to hold a hearing to adopt a GSP for our Basin in accordance with §10728.4 of the California Water Code.

The SSJ GSA was formed under SGMA regulations and joined through a Memorandum of Agreement with the other GSAs in the San Luis Obispo County portion of the Basin, that include the City of Paso Robles GSA, the San Miguel CSD GSA and the Paso Basin-San Luis Obispo County GSA to create and administer a GSP for the Basin.
